



2025 Annual Notice of Covered Battery-Embedded Products Under SB 1215

This notice is provided in compliance with California Public Resources Code (PRC) Section 42466.2, as amended by SB 1215 (Newman, Chapter 370, Statutes of 2022). SB 1215 expands the Covered Electronic Waste (CEW) Recycling Program to include "covered battery-embedded products," which are products containing a battery that is not designed to be easily removed by the user using no more than commonly used household tools. Starting January 1, 2026, retailers must collect a Covered Battery Embedded Waste Recycling Fee (the "Recycling Fee") from consumers at the time of retail sale for new or refurbished covered battery-embedded products. The Recycling Fee amount was established by CalRecycle on September 16, 2025 (<https://content.govdelivery.com/accounts/CALRECYCLE/bulletins/3f545ef>), based on the reasonable regulatory costs to administer the CEW Recycling Program (PRC §42464(b)(3)). Retailers may retain 3% of the collected fee as reimbursement for collection costs.

This annual notice identifies Covered Battery-Embedded Products manufactured by Streamlight, that are subject to the Recycling Fee. Battery chemistry information is available on www.streamlight.com. All listed products are identified by brand and model number, as required. This notice applies to products sold or offered for sale in California.
